- Every participant will be entered in a raffle to win prizes.

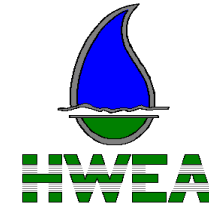

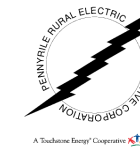

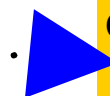

**What is the
Ready Reader
Road Rally?**

It's a competition. It's a challenge. It's a scavenger hunt. It's a digital photo contest. It's a fundraiser to ensure that our youngest citizens enter school 'READY TO READ'.

The money raised will fund the Ready to Read projects of the Christian County Library & Literacy Council. These projects include:

- Newborn Ready to Read bags, books, and bibs that are sent home from JSMC with every newborn's family
- Ready to Read Story Hours for parents and toddlers featuring free books for those at each weekly session
- Reading Workshops for area daycare staffs
- Reading Promise Program for families

The Ready Reader Road Rally mission: Be the first two-member team to return to the start/finish line at the Hopkinsville-Christian County Public Library Parking Lot after successfully completing all checkpoints and getting required photos.

The Ready Reader Road Rally is part scavenger hunt/part digital photo hunt to find checkpoints throughout the city. To move on, teams must take photos and get their passport stamped at each checkpoint (think: Amazing Race!). Each team must determine its own route to the checkpoint.

Use of wireless devices (cell phones, texting, GPS, Internet) is highly encouraged. All teams should set off with mobile phones and digital camera capability.

Teams must have their own transportation. Cars will be needed due to the distance across our city. Each checkpoint has some historical or other significance to Hopkinsville and/or Christian County.

At the end of the Road Rally, teams must be able to show the required photos were taken to complete the Road Rally Passport. The perfect tool for the race is a phone with camera, Internet and GPS. Any digital camera on which you can show your pictures will do.

Competing safely is our number one concern. There is no set course, and there will be no blocked off streets for teams to race through. Please obey all traffic laws. Racers may not interfere with other teams or block their progress.

At least one participant per two-member team must be 16 years of age or older, and each team must provide its own vehicle. Participants under the age of 18 must also have a signed parent release form. Parents may sign up as a team of two and have children accompany them if they desire to make it a family event. The cost is \$50 per team.
